

Steps to Becoming a New Member

Who Are New Members?

New Members are the lifeline of **MABCBK** and are very important to building the Kingdom of God. At **MABCBK**, New Members are defined as those who are new converts, candidates for baptism, and/or believers who are joining MABCBK based on previous Christian experience.

Requirements

Each new member is required to attend New Members Orientation that is held once a month. The New Members Ministry facilitator will contact new members to welcome them and schedule them for their class and/or baptism. New Members Orientation is usually facilitated by a New Members Ministry Leader.

Celebration

New members are recognized on 1st Sundays. We encourage new members to invite at least 5 family members and friends who are not connected to a ministry to celebrate with them. This is a way to have people celebrate with you, and also a way for us to introduce new people to the MABCBK experience.

General Guidelines for MABCBK

The house of God is designed for people to gather for worship, prayer, study, fellowship, and celebrations. Please adhere to the following guidelines so that we may continue to serve God's people **"decently and in order."**

- Announcements If you desire to have a ministry announcement, please make sure that your ministry leader submits it to the Dream Team during our monthly meetings as we seek to plan and approve everything 90 days (3 months) advance.
- All Check Requests submitted by ministries must be approved by the finance team and/or pastor before a check is released.
 NO EXCEPTIONS. If an event will include a guest speaker or musician that will require an honorarium, a signed IRS W-9 form from that party must be submitted before a check is released.
- Ministry Event Submission Deadlines for Dream Team Meeting

January (for events/programs from May-August) May (for events/programs from Sept. – Dec.) September (for events/programs from Jan – April)

• The use of decorations, the re-arranging of furniture, attachment materials to the walls and items of similar nature shall be done **ONLY** with the supervision of members from the decoration ministry.

General Guidelines for MABCBK

- Equipment for activities held outside of the Church cannot be loaned or rented.
- All music instruments are to be used by music staff persons only.
- Absolutely no **soliciting or selling** of any unauthorized items on the premises.
- Absolutely no materials or flyers that's not **MABCBK** related can be placed on cars.
- WALKING We ask that there is no walking during Sermon, Invitation to Discipleship, Tithes & Offering Period, and Benediction. In the event you MUST go to the restroom, we ask that you please remain in the rear of the Church as a loving MABCBK usher directs you when you return to prevent any distraction from other members who are in the service.
- Please do not leave donated items (clothes, toys, equipment, etc.) on the premises without prior authorization from the Church Office and/or Ministry Leader.
- **MABCBK** will not be responsible for theft or any damages to personal equipment/items left on the premises without proper consent from the Pastor and/or Finance Team.
- Membership Updates Membership records are strictly confidential. In an effort to maintain accurate information for each member of MABCBK, we ask that you update your contact information by contacting the Church office at (718) 342-1571 or via email at ExecutiveAssistant@mountararatchurch.com Please place in the subject box "Membership Record Update."

Communications

Ministry Facilitators and ministry leaders will have open monthly meetings (Dream Team) with the Pastor. Ministry concerns and questions should be presented at these sessions.

In the event of an extreme emergency, Dream Team Leaders are available at each worship service for immediate attention. Further questions can also be forwarded to the specific ministry or **pastor@mountararatchurch.com**

Ministry Function & Interaction

Ministry functions are designed to take place on campus. As a precaution, all off-site ministry meetings, events or functions must receive consent from the Pastor in order to function as a representation of **MABCBK.** This is to assure that the brand of the ministry is represented respectfully and properly.

Ministry Involvement

So that our ministries can be accessible and beneficial to everyone, regardless of their Church affiliation, **MABCBK** does not employ membership requirements to join or participate in a ministry. Membership requirement is only necessary to hold leadership positions.

Ministries

Associate Ministers

This ministry is designed for people who believe they have a call on their life into the ministry of preaching. They assist Pastor with teaching, preaching, and ministry support. If you believe you have a call on your life, call the Church office and schedule a meeting with Pastor Carter. **Pastor@mountararatchurch.com**

Deacons

This ministry is designed to assist pastor with the visiting the sick, administrating communion, facilitating baptisms, supervising facility events, etc. Members are selected by the Pastor and the present deacons. Once selected, you must serve a trial period of six months before you are given the rights and responsibility of a deacon.

Finance Team

People with financial training who are selected by the Pastor to manage the finances of the Church. Also work with vendors, budgets, event planning, etc. All finance members are selected by the Pastor and present finance team. **Background check required.**

New Members

Assist with new members assimilation. Making sure new members received all necessary information and guide them from the time they join the Church through their New Members Class and into a ministry. Register by emailing **NewMembers@mountararatchurch.com**





- Maintain social media and public presence that is not contrary to your leadership role in the Christian Church
- Commit to the vision of the Church
- Regularly attend worship service

The Use of Offering Envelopes and Church Contributions

We recommend that **ALL** contributions, whether by check, debit, or cash, made to our church be given in an appropriate offering envelope. Please be certain that your name, address, and other requested information is printed *clearly* to ensure that you receive proper credit. To many, using envelopes may seem like a nuisance at first (especially for a small cash offering.) However, over a year, those small offerings can add up to a substantial amount. Using offering envelope also makes the accounting task for the finance ministry easier.

You may also create an account with our Church App Giving by downloading **GIVELIFY App** and looking up **"Mount Ararat Baptist Church Brooklyn, New York."** This method has proven to be quick and easy. It also records all of your given for the year and sends you a statement at the end of the year.







Questions & Answers

I want to join, but I am a member of another Church.

Remain prayerful and ask God to lead you in your decision. Our goal is not to recruit members from other local ministries, but we are committed to accepting people who know that they are being led to **MABCBK.** Before making a decision to join, be prayerful that where you are, is not where God wants you to be.

What am I going to wear to Church today?

You are able to dress casual every Sunday. We are a **C.A.Y.A** Ministry, which means **Come as You Are**. Our focus is not being impressed by you **clothes** externally, but to be impacting for your **soul** internally.

Why do you use Sermon Handouts?

We do this to allow you to be able to retain the messages that you heard on any given Sunday. Most people forget the message they heard less than 48hrs after worship. This method allows you to remember and share with others as a form of encouragement.

Is the church impacting the community?

Yes! **MABCBK** is intentionally involved in impacting our community through personal and partnership activities. We believe that we were placed where we are to *Empower People to Live Beyond Life Limitations*. John 10:10 "...I come that you might have life, and have it more abundantly."

I am upset with a member and/or the Pastor and I am considering leaving the Church.

No one is perfect, not even the Pastor or you. In this event, we ask that you request a meeting with the person you have been offended by. 
